PROGRAM INFORMATION

- Transitional Residential Program
- On-site staff 24 hours a day
- Visiting hours: 9am-11pm
- Quiet hours: 9pm-8am
- Curfew is midnight
- Apartments are partially furnished
- 12-18 month program
- Co-educational
- Respect for everyone
- Participation in activities of daily living
- Chores done regularly
- Meet with treatment team weekly
- Engaged in a treatment/therapeutic program
- Sleeping/napping during the day is discouraged, unless ill
- Sign out each time you leave the program
- Possession or consumption of any illegal drugs/alcohol is grounds for immediate termination from program
- Smoking is not permitted inside the program
- Staff may conduct regular room searches
